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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to make valid the doings of the annual town meeting  
of the town of Jackson, Waldo County.

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Whereas, it is important to the stability and safety of the town of Jackson in the county of Waldo that the validity of the acts of the annual town meeting be beyond question. And, whereas by reason of the foregoing fact this act is necessary for the public peace and safety and in the opinion of the Legislature constitutes an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution, now therefore:

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The annual town meeting of the town of Jack-

2 son in the county of Waldo, held on the fifth day of March,  
3 nineteen hundred seventeen, is hereby ratified and made le-  
4 gal and valid notwithstanding any informality in making the  
5 town clerk's record of said meeting.

Sect. 2. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble  
2 this act, two thirds of the members elected to each House,  
3 having so directed, shall take effect when approved.
