House of Representatives, February 14, 1917.

STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

Ordered, That a committee of three (3) be appointed by
2 the Speaker, and authority is hereby given said committee
3 to purchase for the House of Representatives new desks
4 and chairs of good quality and modern design, and to have
5 them installed by the Superintendent of Public Buildings
6 as soon as practicable.

The Superintendent of Public Buildings is hereby author-
2 ized to sell at the close of the final session of this year, the
3 old desks and chairs at the best obtainable price.

Before selling the desks and chairs in the market, the Su-
2 perintendent of Buildings shall give to each member the op-
3 tion to purchase the desk and chair assigned to him at this
4 session at the market price.
