STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE in favor of the erection of a state sanatorium in the county of Aroostook for the treatment of persons suffering from tuberculosis.

Resolved, That there be, and is hereby, appropriated, for 2 the year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of twenty thou-3 sand (\$20,000.00) dollars, to be expended under the direction of the "Board of Trustees for Tuberculosis Sanato-5 riums" as defined by Chapter 146, Revised Statutes, and 6 the governor and council, in the construction, including all 7 necessary expenses incident thereto, of a sanatorium in the 8 county of Aroostook for the care and treatment of persons

9 suffering from tuberculosis, to be known as the Northern 10 Maine Sanatorium, and to be a part of the state system of 11 tuberculosis sanatoriums established, maintained and gov- 12 erned by the terms of said Chapter 146, Revised Statutes; 13 provided that the citizens of Aroostook county shall first 14 have secured and conveyed to the State of Maine a site, 15 satisfactory to the said Board of Trustees for Tuberculosis 16 Sanatoriums, suitable for the erection of such an institution; provided further that the building or buildings erected 18 under the terms of this resolve shall contain suitable accommodations for patients, nurses and attendants and adminion istration offices, and provided also that any unexpended balances of the above sum not required for construction purposes shall be available for expenditure for furniture and 23 equipment.
