STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE relating to the conservation of the storage reservoirs and water powers of the State of Maine.

Resolved, the Senate concurring, it is the opinion of the 2 Seventy-eighth Legislature of Maine, now in session, that 3 the storage reservoirs and basins in this State should be 4 conserved in some manner for the benefit of the people and 5 the industries of the State and that no steps should be taken 6 that will discourage capital from continuing old industries 7 or establishing new ones in this State, or that will make it 8 more difficult for the people of the State to be supplied with 9 light and power; And

That it is the opinion of the Legislature that steps should 2 be taken to determine what rights of ownership, if any, the 3 State has in storage reservoirs and basins and in water pow-4 ers; And

That the State should not part with its rights in any water 2 power or storage reservoir or basin, except after investiga-3 tion and report by some competent authority acting for it; 4 And

In pursuance of the foregoing, the Public Utilities Com-2 mission is hereby directed and ordered to make a careful 3 and thorough investigation of both the developed and un-4 developed water powers and of the water storage reser-5 voirs and basins of this State, showing what rights remain 6 to the State therein, and what are the possibilities of de-7 velopment and the probable cost of the same; And

The said Commission is hereby directed and ordered to 2 take up and continue the work begun by the State Water 3 Storage Commission which was created by Chapter two 4 hundred twelve of the Laws of Maine for nineteen hundred 5 nine; And

The said Commission is further directed to make a full 2 report with such recommendations as it may deem advis-3 able, to the next Legislature; And

It is further ordered that the sum of five (\$5000) thou-2 sand dollars is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen 3 hundred seventeen and the sum of five (\$5000) thousand
4 dollars for the year nineteen hundred eighteen, to be used
5 by the said Public Utilities Commission in carrying out the
6 purposes of this Resolution.
