STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Co-operative Survey of the Boundary Line between the State of Maine and the State of New Hampshire.

Resolved:

Section 1. That the Governor of the State be authorized
2 to appoint a surveyor on the part of the State of Maine
3 who shall have power under his direction and in conjunc-
4 tion with a surveyor to be appointed on the part of the
5 State of New Hampshire to ascertain, survey and mark the
6 dividing line between the State of Maine and the State of
7 New Hampshire; and, in conjunction with the proper

8 county and town official of the counties and towns inter-
9 sected by said State, erect or cause to be erected permanent
10 monuments at the place of intersection of any county, town
11 or highway line with said state line, and said monuments,
12 in addition to such words, letters and dates thereon, as may
13 be deemed necessary, shall have the elevations above sea
14 level indicated upon them.

Sect. 2. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars is hereby
2 appropriated to be used therefor on the part of the State of
3 Maine when a like sum shall have been appropriated by the
4 State of New Hampshire to defray its part of the expenses
5 of said joint survey and markings.

Sect. 3. On completion of said survey, the boundary
2 line so marked shall be and is hereby accepted as the
3 official boundary line between the State of Maine and the
4 State of New Hampshire.
