STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 235, Section 3 of the Public Laws
of 1915, providing for the granting of Lobster Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. First paragraph section three of chapter two
2 hundred thirty-five of the Revised Statutes is hereby
3 amended by adding after the word "license" in the fourth
4 line thereof the following: 'or any person having a summer
5 residence in this state,' so that said section as amended shall
6 read as follows:

'The Commissioner of Sea and Shore Fisheries shall grant

2 and issue licenses to any citizen of this state, or to any person
3 having resided in this state for more than one year immedi-
4 ately preceding the date of the application for license, or to
5 any person having a summer residence in this state or to
6 corporations or firms engaged in the lobster business located
7 in this state or other states, to catch, take, hold, buy, ship,
8 transport, carry, give away, remove, sell or expose for sale,
9 within this state and have in his possession, lobsters from
10 the waters within the jurisdiction of this state in the manner,
11 at the time and subject to the regulations provided in this
12 act.'
