#### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to appropriate moneys for the payment of salaries fixed by law for the year one thousand nine hundred seventeen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In order to provide for the payment of salaries

- 2 fixed by law, for the current fiscal year one thousand nine
- 3 hundred seventeen, the following sums are hereby appropri-
- 4 ated out of any moneys in the state treasury, and, except
- 5 where otherwise specially provided, the Governor with the
- 6 advice and consent of the Council, is hereby authorized at

7	any time prior to the first day of January, one thousand nine
8	hundred eighteen, to draw his warrant on the state treasurer
9	for the same.
