STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter twenty-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen relating to salary of the judge of the Municipal Court of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter twenty-three of the
2 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen
3 is hereby amended so that as amended it shall read as fol-
4 lows:

'Section 1. The salary of the judge of the municipal court
2 for the City of Portland, shall be twenty-eight hundred dol-
3 lars per annum, payable quarterly, in full of all services.'
