STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter twenty-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen relating to salary of the Recorder of the Municipal Court for the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of Chapter twenty-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen is hereby amended so that as amended it shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The salary of the recorder of the municipal

2 court for the City of Portland, shall be twenty-five hundred
3 dollars, which shall be in full for all services, and it shall be
4 the duty of said recorder to make and post all copies of
5 libels and monitions in liquor cases.'
