STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter 396 of Private and Special Laws of 1909, authorizing the construction of a bridge across Ogunquit River, in the town of Wells.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Chapter 396 of the Private and Special Laws of 1909 is 2 hereby amended by striking out in the first line thereof the 3 words "town of Wells" and inserting in place thereof the 4 words 'Ogunquit Village Corporation,' also by inserting 5 after the words "York County" in the second line the words 6 'or George H. Littlefield,' also by substituting in the fourth

7 line in place of the name of George L. Fowler, the name of8 said George H. Littlefield; so that said act as amended shall9 read as follows:

'Authority is hereby granted to the Ogunquit Village Cor-2 poration or the county commissioners of York County or 3 George H. Littlefield, to construct a bridge with necessary 4 approaches, across tide waters in Ogunquit River, at some 5 convenient point near land of said George H. Littlefield, in 6 the town of Wells.'
