STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section I of Chapter XI, Revised Statutes of Maine relating to the collection of Taxes and the Commitment of Poll Taxes in Incorporated Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I of Chapter XI of the Revised Statutes of Maine

be amended by inserting in the fourth line of said Section

I, between the word "that" and the word "the" the follow
ing words: if no action is taken all taxes shall be due and

payable August Ist, except that any town or city may pro-

6 vide at its annual meeting that,' so that said Section I of

7 Chapter XI as amended shall read as follows:

'Towns, at their annual meetings, may determine when the 2 lists named in Section Eighty-five of Chapter Ten shall be 3 committed, and when their taxes shall be payable, and that 4 interest shall be collected thereafter; provided, however, 5 that if no action is taken all taxes shall be due and payable 6 August 1st, except that any town or city may provide at 7 its annual meeting that the poll taxes shall be due and pay-8 able on the first day of May, in which case the commitment 9 of the lists of poll-tax payers shall be made to the collector 10 prior to that date.'
