IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to repeal Chapter twenty-nine of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and forty-two, and Chapter twenty-six of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred sixty-one; relating to Bull Rock Bridge, on the New Meadows River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

4 one are hereby repealed.
