STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 32 of Chapter 33 of the Revised Statutes (1916) relating to the depositing of mill waste in the inland waters of the state.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 32 of Chapter 33 of the Revised Statutes (1916) is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and by substituting therefor the following:

'Sect. 22. No person or corporation shall place or deposit in any of the inland waters of the state, or allow the same to be done by anyone in their employ, any slabs, edg-

4 ings, sawdust, chips, bark, mill waste, shavings or fibrous
5 material created in the manufacture of lumber, or place or
6 deposit the same on the banks of any of the inland waters of
7 the state in such negligent or careless manner that the same
8 shall fall or be washed into said waters, or with the intent
9 that the same shall fall or be washed into said waters.
10 Whoever violates any provision of this section shall pay a
11 fine of not less than five dollars and not exceeding one hun-
12 dred dollars and costs for each offense.'
