STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT additional to Chapter 87 of the Revised Statutes relating to Proceedings in Civil Actions in Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter eighty-seven of the Revised Statutes is hereby 2 amended by adding, at the end thereof:

'In the trial of all civil actions a verdict shall be returned 2 when nine members of the jury concur; and only those 3 jurors who concur as aforesaid shall participate in the 4 assessment of damages therein, if any.'
