STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT in Relation to Annual or Biennial Reports of State
Charitable and Correctional Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The annual report of the warden and inspectors of the
2 state prison and jails and of the trustees of the Reforma-
3 tory for Women as required by Chapter 142, Revised
4 Statutes, the annual reports of the juvenile trustees and
5 officers of the juvenile institutions as prescribed by Chap-
6 ter 144, Revised Statutes, of the trustees and officers of
7 the state hospitals and of the School for the Feeble Minded

8 as prescribed by Chapter 145, Revised Statutes, of the
9 trustees of the state sanatoriums as prescribed by Chapter
10 146, Revised Statutes, and the biennial report of the Bath
11 Military and Naval Orphan Asylum, shall hereafter be
12 made to the governor and council biennially, on or before
13 the thirtieth day of September in each year next preceding
14 the regular session of the legislature for the two year period
15 ending on the thirtieth day of June prior thereto, and a
16 copy of the same shall at the same time be transmitted to
17 the State Board of Charities and Corrections. So much of
18 Section 1, Chapter 3, Revised Statutes and of said Chapters
19 142, 144, 145 and 146, Revised Statutes as are inconsistent
20 with the foregoing are hereby repealed.
