STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to legalize and make valid the proceedings of the
Annual School Meeting of the City of Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The annual school meeting in the City of Augusta, held
2 on the second Monday of May nineteen hundred sixteen,
3 at half past seven o'clock in the evening, in the city hall of
4 said city, is hereby ratified and made legal and valid, and
5 all of the proceedings of said meeting are hereby ratified,
6 confirmed and made valid.
