STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to provide for the payment to Bustin's Island Village Corporation, of a proportion of the money received from taxation by the Town of Freeport, from the territory embraced within the limits of said Bustin's Island Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Freeport shall annually pay over
2 to the treasurer of Bustin's Village Corporation out of the
3 taxes collected from the inhabitants and estates on Bustin's
4 Island, within a reasonable time after such collection, a sum
5 equal to seventy-five percentum of all the town taxes, ex-
6 clusive of the state and county tax, collected from said in-
7 habitants and estates.

Sect. 2. Said corporation and the overseers thereof shall
2 have the same power and duties in laying out and discon-
3 tinuing and altering town ways on Bustin's Island which the
4 town of Freeport and the selectmen now have to be exer-
5 cised and performed under the same conditions and limita-
6 tions and in the same manner that they are now exercised
7 and performed by said town and its selectmen.

Sect. 3. The town of Freeport is hereby relieved from
2 any and all duties to build, repair or maintain roads, streets
3 or ways upon said Bustin's Island, or to build schoolhouses,
4 or to maintain schools thereon, or to perform any of the
5 duties for which said corporation is authorized, by section
6 2, of said act, to raise money.

Sect. 4. All acts or parts of acts in conflict herewith are
2 hereby repealed.
