# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Chapter One Hundred Sixty-four of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fifteen, Relating to "An Act to Provide for the Establishment of a Board of Recreation for the City of Portland."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section Six of Chapter One Hundred Sixty-four of the 2 Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fif-3 teen, relating to "An Act to Provide for the Establishment

- 4 of a Board of Recreation for the City of Portland" is
- 5 hereby amended by striking out the word "ten" in the

6 fourth and sixth lines of said section, and substituting 7 therefor the word 'fifteen,' so that said section as amended 8 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 6. For the purposes of carrying out the provisions 2 of this act, the board of park commissioners are hereby 3 ordered, authorized and directed to pay over to the recreation commission annually fifteen percentum of the amount 5 annually appropriated by the city council of the city of 6 Portland for park purposes, said fifteen percentum to be 7 paid in equal quarterly payments on the first day of Jan-8 uary, April, July and October of each year.'
