STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Extend the Rights, Powers and Privileges of the
Guilford Manufacturing Company for the Erection and Main-
tenance of Piers and Booms in the Piscataquis River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges, which were granted to
2 the Guilford Manufacturing Company, by sections one and
3 two of chapter two hundred and twenty of the Private and
4 Special Laws of the year nineteen hundred and nine, are
5 hereby revived and extended, for and during the period of
6 ten years from the date on which this act takes effect, and

7 the rights, powers and privileges that were thereby granted
8 may be exercised in the same manner and for the same pur-
9 poses as provided in said sections one and two of said act.
