HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

JOINT RESOLUTION in favor of universal military training under the Federal Government.

Whereas, the necessity of adequate military defense is the
2 most vital issue before the American people, and

Whereas, the permanent safety of the nation demands efficient
2 training of the young men of the country that they
3 may be properly prepared to render instantly effective military
4 tary service in time of war,

Be it Resolved, that the Senate and House of Representatives
2 in Legislature assembled are heartily in favor of any

3 fair and equitable law establishing a system of universal
4 military training under the direction of the Federal Govern-
5 ment;

Be it further Resolved, that a copy of this resolution be
2 sent to our Senators and Representatives in Congress by
3 the Secretary of State.
