STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 48, Chapter 56 of the Revised Statutes of 1916, relating to inspection of railroads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 48 of Chapter 56 of the Revised Statutes of 1916
2 is hereby amended so that said section as amended will read
3 as follows:

'Sect. 48. Public utilities commission to examine railroads
2 and make annual reports. R. S. c. 51, Sec. 50. 1911, c.
3 165. The public utilities commission, or one member there-
4 of, or some competent person by said commission duly ap-
5 pointed, annually, and at any other time on application or
6 whenever they think necessary, shall carefully examine the

7 tracks, rolling-stock, bridges, viaducts, and culverts of all
8 railroads; and shall annually make a report to the governor
9 of their official doings, therein stating the condition of the
10 road and rolling-stock, with such facts as they deem of
11 public interest or which he may require; and all persons
12 managing railroads shall give the commission such informa-
13 tion as they at any time require.'

The purpose of this act is to re-enact Chap. 215, 1913, omitted from the revision.
