STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT providing penalty for defacing identification marks on
motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever knowingly, buys, sells, receives, disposes of, con-
2 ceals or has in his possession any motor vehicle, as defined in
3 Section one of the Automobile Laws, from which the manu-
4 facturer's serial number or any other distinguishing number
5 or identification mark has been removed, defaced, covered,
6 altered or destroyed for the purpose of concealment or mis-
7 representing the identity of the said motor vehicle, shall be
8 fined not more than two hundred dollars or imprisoned not
9 more than six months, or both.
