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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to amend Chapter 150 of the Private and Special  
Laws of 1903 relative to Alumni Trustees of Colby College.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

That Section 3 of an act entitled "An Act to establish a  
2 Literary Institution in the District of Maine within this  
3 Commonwealth" passed by the General Court of Massa-  
4 chusetts and approved February 27, 1813, be further  
5 amended by striking out from the last sentence of said sec-  
6 tion, as amended by said Chapter 150 of the Private and  
7 Special Laws of 1903, the word "nine" and inserting in the

8 place thereof the word 'ten' and by striking out the word  
9 "three" before the words "each year" and inserting in the  
10 place thereof the word 'two,' and by striking out the words  
11 "three" before the word "years" and inserting in the place  
12 thereof the word 'five.' So that said section three as  
13 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. Be it further enacted, that for the more orderly  
2 conducting the business of the said corporation, the presi-  
3 dent and trustees shall have full power and authority, from  
4 time to time as they shall determine, to elect a vice presi-  
5 dent, treasurer and secretary of said corporation, and to  
6 declare the tenure and duties of their respective offices, and  
7 also to remove any trustee from the said corporation, when  
8 in their judgment he shall be rendered incapable by age or  
9 other ways, of discharging the duties of his office, and to  
10 fill up all vacancies in the said corporation, by electing such  
11 persons for trustees, except as hereinafter provided, as they  
12 shall judge best: Provided nevertheless, that the number  
13 of the said corporation, including the president of the said  
14 institution, and the treasurer for the time being, shall never  
15 be greater than thirty-one, nor less than twenty-one: And  
16 provided also, that ten of the trustees shall be elected by  
17 the Alumni Association of Colby College to be known as  
18 Alumni Trustees and to be elected, two each year, for terms  
19 of five years, in such manner as said association may pro-  
20 vide.'
