STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT requiring highway bridges and railroad crossings to
be covered with snow during the winter season.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Road Commissioners shall keep the travelled part of all
2 highway bridges in their respective cities, towns and planta-
3 tions, and railroads and street railways shall keep all high-
4 way crossings on their respective lines suitably covered
5 with snow whenever the usual travel over the same is in
6 vehicles on runners.
