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RESOLVE in Favor of John E. Sewall and C. F. A. Phair.

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*Resolved,* That the sum of four hundred and twenty-two  
2 dollars and twenty-seven cents be, and hereby is, appro-  
3 priated to be paid John E. Sewall and C. F. A. Phair, of  
4 Presque Isle, to reimburse them for money expended for  
5 screening the outlet of Squa Pan lake, in Aroostook County.



## STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the spring of 1916 this lake was screened, under the supervision of a representative of the inland fish and game commission, the total expense thereof being one thousand and forty-four dollars and fifty-four cents, which was paid by Messrs. Sewall and Phair. Toward the payment of this claim individuals have subscribed and paid two hundred dollars. The Legislature of nineteen hundred and thirteen made an appropriation of two hundred and fifty dollars toward the screening of this lake but this appropriation was never used. In view of the fact that the screen cost much more than they anticipated, Messrs. Sewall and Phair think the state should make a larger appropriation than that of nineteen hundred and thirteen. The original resolve asked for an appropriation of eight hundred and forty-four dollars and fifty-four cents and was accompanied by vouchers covering the amount expended for the screen.
