HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to extend and amend the charter of the Fairfield  
and Skowhegan Railway Company.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

The rights, powers and privileges of the Fairfield and Skow-  
2 hegan Railway Company, which were granted by chapter  
3 two hundred sixty of the Private and Special Laws of nine-  
4 teen hundred seven, and extended by chapter eleven of the  
5 Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred nine, and  
6 extended by chapter fifty-two of the Private and Special  
7 Laws of nineteen hundred eleven, and extended by chapter

8 fifty-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hun-  
9 dred thirteen, to Forrest Goodwin of Skowhegan, Byron  
10 Boyd, H. L. Pishon and Frank E. Smith of Augusta, and  
11 Edward S. Clark of Eden, their associates, successors and  
12 assigns, and extended by chapter fifty-seven of the Private  
13 and Special Laws of nineteen hundred fifteen to H. L. Swett  
14 of Skowhegan, Byron Boyd, H. L. Pishon, Frank E. Smith  
15 of Augusta and Edward S. Clark of Eden, their associates,  
16 successors and assigns, are hereby extended for two years  
17 from the date of the approval of this act, to H. L. Swett  
18 of Skowhegan, Byron Boyd, H. L. Pishon, Frank E. Smith  
19 of Augusta and Edward S. Clark of Eden, their associates,  
20 successors and assigns, and the said persons named in said  
21 act with the exception of Forrest Goodwin and inserting  
22 the name of H. L. Swett therefor, their associates, succes-  
23 sors and assigns, shall have all the rights, powers and privi-  
24 leges that were granted in said act to the said Forrest Good-  
25 win, Byron Boyd, H. L. Pishon, Frank E. Smith and Ed-  
26 ward S. Clark, to be exercised in the same manner and for  
27 the same purposes as provided in said act.
