#### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to extend the time within which the provisions of Chapter 186 of the Private and Special Laws of 1915, providing for reorganization or consolidation of the railroad companies constituting the Boston and Maine railroad system, may be exercised.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The prescribed time within which action may 2 be taken by the Boston and Maine Railroad, under Section 3 4 of Chapter 186 of the Private and Special Laws of 1915, 4 and the time prescribed for the exercise by it of special

- 5 powers under Section 8 of said act and the time within 6 which a new corporation may be organized under Section 7 9 and subsequent sections of said act are hereby extended 8 respectively to July 1, 1919.
- Sect. 2. All other provisions of said act are hereby re-2 enacted and made in full force and effect.
