STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section fifty-nine of Chapter four of the Revised Statutes of nineteen hundred and sixteen, relating to towns, their meetings, officers, powers and duties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifty-nine of Chapter four of the Revised Statutes

- 2 of nineteen hundred and sixteen relating to towns, their
- 3 meetings, officers, powers and duties is hereby amended by
- 4 striking out the words in the first and second lines thereof
- 5 "having not more than fifty thousand inhabitants" so that
- 6 said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 58. Any city or town may appropriate any sum, not 2 exceeding one mill on a dollar, based on the valuation of the 3 preceding year, to be expended and used for advertising the 4 natural resources, advantages and attractions of such city or 5 town.'
