AN ACT to extend the powers of the Milo Electric Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. The Milo Electric Light and Power Company
2 is hereby authorized and empowered to extend its trans-3 mission lines into Township numbered Six, Ninth Range of
4 lots N. W. P. Piscataquis county, the plantation of Barnard,
5 the towns of Williamsburg, Bowerbank, Atkinson, Orneville
6 and Medford all in the said county of Piscataquis, and the
7 towns of LaGrange and Bradford in the county of Penob-

8 scot and such extensions may be used for all the purposes 9 specified in the Certificate of Organization of said Milo 10 Electric Light and Power Company as ratified and confirmed 11 by Chapter Three Hundred Fifty-eight, Private and Special 12 Laws of the year Nineteen Hundred Five.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal or 2 shall be construed as repealing the whole or any part of any 3 existing statute. And all the rights and duties herein men-4 tioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance with 5 all the applicable provisions of Chapter 129 of the Public 6 Laws of the State of Maine for the year 1913, as from time 7 to time amended.
