IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE. HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-three of Chapter Twentysix of the Revised Statutes Fixing a Fee for Motor Cars Registering in Neutral Automobile Zones.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section twenty-three of chapter twenty-six of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding after the last
paragraph of said section, which reads as follows: "Ten
dollars for traction engines or log haulers (used for commercial purposes)" the following additional paragraph to
6 said section twenty-three:

"Two dollars for every motor vehicle owned by a non-resi-2 dent who applies for registration under the provisions of 3 section thirty-six of this chapter."
