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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to amend Section Ten of Chapter 117 of the Revised  
Statutes relating to Stenographers of the Supreme Judicial  
Court.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section ten of chapter one hundred seventeen of the Re-  
vised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words  
"fifteen hundred" in the second line thereof and inserting  
in place thereof the words 'two thousand' so that said sec-  
tion as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 10. Stenographers appointed by the justices of the

2 supreme judicial court shall receive annual salaries of two  
3 thousand dollars each, in full for all services formerly  
4 chargeable to the counties. They shall also receive from  
5 the county in which the court is held, their expenses when  
6 in attendance upon court away from their place of resi-  
7 dence, but not otherwise; a detailed statement of such ex-  
8 penses, actually and reasonably incurred shall be approved  
9 by the presiding justice.'
