STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

---

RESOLVE, in favor of the Maine School for the Feeble  
Minded for maintenance and other purposes for the years  
nineteen hundred seventeen and nineteen hundred eighteen.

---

*Resolved:* That there be, and hereby is, appropriated:  
FOR THE MAINE SCHOOL, FOR THE FEEBLE  
MINDED.

For personal services, namely, for salaries and wages of all  
2 officers and employees except those wholly engaged in re-  
3 pairs of buildings and equipment, for the year nineteen hun-  
4 dred seventeen, the sum of twenty-five thousand

5 (\$25,000.00) dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred  
6 eighteen, the sum of twenty-six thousand (\$26,000.00)  
7 dollars.

For food supplies, namely, all articles of food, for the year  
2 nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of twenty-four thou-  
3 sand (\$24,000.00) dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred  
4 eighteen, the sum of twenty-eight thousand (\$28,000.00)  
5 dollars.

For clothing, namely, all articles of personal clothing and  
2 materials for making the same, for the year nineteen hun-  
3 dred seventeen, the sum of five thousand (\$5,000.00) dollars,  
4 and for the year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of six  
5 thousand (\$6,000.00) dollars.

For repairs and equipment, namely, all materials and sup-  
2 plies required for upkeep of grounds, buildings and attached  
3 fixtures; all additions to and repairs and replacements of  
4 furniture and equipment, including farm equipment and  
5 livestock, and all personal services rendered wholly in con-  
6 nection with repair work, for the year nineteen hundred  
7 seventeen, the sum of nine thousand (\$9,000.00) dollars,  
8 and for the year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of ten  
9 thousand (\$10,000.00) dollars.

For general expenses, namely, all other materials, supplies  
2 and expenses incident to maintenance of the institution and  
3 the inmates thereof, whether present or absent, for the year  
4 nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of eleven thousand  
5 seven hundred and sixty-five (\$11,765.00) dollars, and for

6 the year nineteen hundred eighteen, the sum of ten thousand  
7 one hundred (\$10,100.00) dollars.

For construction of central heating and power plant for the  
2 year nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of twenty-five  
3 thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars.

For construction and improvement for the year nineteen  
2 hundred eighteen, the sum of one hundred thousand  
3 (\$100,000.00) dollars.

*Provided*, that any balance of the sums above appropriated  
2 for the year nineteen hundred seventeen which may remain  
3 unexpended at the end of the year shall be available for ex-  
4 penditure during the year nineteen hundred eighteen, and  
5 provided further, that the Governor and Council may, by  
6 order, upon recommendation of the trustees of said institu-  
7 tion, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of the  
8 above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appropria-  
9 tions for such institution.

*Provided also*, that only so much of the above appropriation  
2 for construction and improvement shall be expended as both  
3 the trustees of said institution and the Governor and Council  
4 shall approve, after a thorough study of the situation has  
5 been made.
