RESOLVE in favor of Adaline M. Hanaford.

Resolved, That eight dollars per month be paid to Adaline 2 M. Hanaford of Lewiston in Androscoggin county, payable 3 in quarterly from the fund appropriated for military pen-4 sions, beginning January 1st, 1917.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Adaline M. Hanaford is a woman seventy-five years of age. Her health will not permit her to work, and she is absolutely dependent upon pensions for her livelihood. She gets \$20 per month from the National Government, and with the sum asked for in this resolve, it would just about enable her to live.
