STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Enlarge the Powers of the Western Maine Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. The Western Maine Power Company, formerly
the Limerick Water and Electric Company, a corporation
created and existing by virtue of chapter one hundred fiftynine of the Private and Special Laws of 1907 and acts
amendatory thereof and additional thereto, is hereby authorized and empowered to extend its lines and furnish its
service in any territory within the state of Maine adjacent

8 to any of the towns in its act of incorporation and acts 9 amendatory thereof and additional thereto, provided that it 10 shall not extend its lines into any such adjacent towns in 11 which any other public utility is engaged in selling and dis-12 tributing electricity, without the consent of such public util-13 ity or of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of 14 Maine.

Sect. 2. Said corporation is authorized and empowered 2 to purchase for cash, or by exchange of its stock, securities 3 or property, own and hold the stocks, bonds or debentures 4 of any public utility doing business in the counties of York, 5 Oxford or Cumberland, subject to the approval of the 6 Public Utilities Commission of the State of Maine.

Sect. 3. Said corporation is authorized and empowered 2 to acquire by purchase, lease, merger or consolidation, and 3 to exercise and enjoy after such purchase, lease, merger 4 or consolidation any or all of the rights, privileges, fran-5 chises and property of any public utility organized for sim-6 ilar purposes and doing business in the counties of York, 7 Cumberland or Oxford or in any municipality adjacent to 8 any of the towns named in its act of incorporation or acts 9 amendatory thereof or additional thereto, within the State 10 of Maine with which its wires may be connected to form 11 a continuous system, upon such terms and conditions as 12 may be agreed upon by the said corporation and such other 13 public utility; and said other public utilities are hereby 14 authorized and empowered to lease, sell and convey their

15 respective rights, privileges, franchises and properties to the 16 said Western Maine Power Company or to merge or con-17 solidate with the said company, provided that any such sale, 18 lease, merger or consolidation shall be approved by the Pub-19 lic Utilities Commission of the State of Maine, but it shall 20 be unlawful for said corporation to transmit electric cur-21 rent for sale or use beyond the limits of this state, or to 22 contract with any person or corporation for the transmission 23 or sale of electric current beyond the limits of this state 24 and said corporation shall not be permitted to acquire in 25 any manner the franchises of, or consolidate with or trans-26 fer or lease its property, rights and franchises to any other 27 corporation or person now transmitting or having the right 28 to transmit electric power beyond the confines of the state 29 without authority of the Legislature.
