STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of the Board of Registration of Medicine.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred 3 and seventeen, and the sum of five hundred dollars for the 4 year nineteen hundred and eighteen for the Board of Registration of Medicine, the same to be kept by the state treasfourer as a carrying account, and paid out by him for such 7 compensation and the incidentals and travelling expenses as 8 shall be approved by the board and audited by the governor 9 and council, as provided for in Section 17 of Chapter 18,

10 Revised Statutes of 1916. Before using any of the money 11 hereby appropriated, the treasurer shall use the fees received 12 from the board as specified in said Section 17.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The appropriations are asked for because the receipts from fees by the board have not been sufficient to pay compensation incidental and travelling expenses as provided for in Section 49 and Section 54 of Chapter 117 of the Revised Statutes of 1916.

The receipts have fallen off for the reason that there have been fewer number of applicants for registration.
