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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to Repeal Chapter Two Hundred Seventy-one, Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Eleven, Relating to Ways and Bridges, Plantation Number Fourteen, Washington County.

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Whereas it is necessary that the control of the highway and bridges in plantation number fourteen, Washington County, be taken from said plantation and transferred to the county commissioners of Washington county early in the spring of nineteen hundred and seventeen, and whereas in the judgment of the legislature these facts render the passage of this act im-

mediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety and constitute an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution; now therefore

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Chapter two hundred seventy-one, private and special laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, relating to ways and bridges in plantation number fourteen, in Washington county be and hereby is repealed.

Sect. 2. Because of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.
