IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

---

AN ACT to define and amend the laws in regard to tuition.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Towns or cities admitting to their schools persons of school  
2 age who are temporary residents, or who are employed in  
3 said city or town, shall be recompensed to the same extent  
4 from the school funds of the state as if said persons were  
5 enrolled in manual training or night school.

All acts or portions of acts inconsistent with the foregoing  
2 are hereby repealed.
