# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section One Hundred Seventy-six of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Appropriation for Teachers' Pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred seventy-six of chapter sixteen of the

- 2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
- 3 word "twenty-five" in the second line thereof and substi-
- 4 tuting therefor the word 'twenty-seven' so that said section
- 5 when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 176. For the purposes of the seven preceding

- 2 sections the sum of twenty-seven thousand dollars is an-
- 3 nually appropriated, which sum the treasurer of state shall
- 4 deduct for said purposes out of the school and mill funds
- 5 and the sum so appropriated and deducted shall be denomi-
- 6 nated the school pension fund.'

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The increase in the appropriation for teachers' pensions is made necessary by a slight increase in the number of teachers receiving full pensions.
