STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to annex certain islands in Casco Bay to the County
of Sagadahoc and the Town of Phippsburg.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter two hundred of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred five, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. Bushy, Hen, Bear, Malaga, Burnt Coat, Black Snake, Wood, Little Wood, Gooseberry, are hereby made and declared to be a part of the county of Sagadahoc and of the town of Phippsburg therein.
