## STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE in Favor of the Maine State Prison for Maintenance and Current Expenses.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated:

For the Maine State Prison, for the year nineteen hun-2 dred and seventeen, the sum of thirty-seven thousand, five 3 hundred and fifty dollars, for the purposes hereinafter speci-4 fied, namely:

For the following items fixed by law:

Salaries of subordinate officers, twenty-one thousand, seven 2 hundred dollars.

Schools, fifty dollars. Books, fifty dollars. Medicine, one hundred and fifty dollars. Water supply, two thousand, two hundred dollars. Printing and binding reports, two hundred dollars. Criminal insane, two hundred dollars. Retiring and pensioning prison officials, two thousand, six

2 hundred dollars.

For other purposes, namely:

For sacred concerts, one hundred dollars.

For chaplain for Catholic inmates, three hundred dollars. For all other supplies, materials, services and expenses 2 properly incident to the care of the inmates of said state 3 prison not otherwise specifically appropriated for, ten thou-4 sand dollars.

Provided, that any balances of the foregoing appropria-2 tion which remain unexpended at the end of the year nine-3 teen hundred seventeen shall be available for expenditure 4 during nineteen hundred eighteen.

And be it further resolved, That there be and hereby is 2 appropriated for said Maine State Prison for the year nine-3 teen hundred eighteen, the further sum of thirty-seven thou-4 sand, five hundred and fifty dollars for the same purposes 5 as hereinbefore specified for the year nineteen hundred 6 seventeen.
