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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to change the date of the annual meeting of the  
Farmington Village Corporation.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 7 of chapter 142 of the private and special laws  
2 of 1911 is hereby amended by striking out the first three  
3 lines of said section and inserting in place thereof the fol-  
4 lowing: 'The assessors, clerk and treasurer shall be elected  
5 by ballot at the annual meeting to be held in the month  
6 following the end of the fiscal year as is now or shall here-  
7 after be prescribed by the Public Utilities Commission of

8 the State of Maine,' so that said section as amended shall  
9 read as follows:

'Sect. 7. The assessors, clerk and treasurer shall be elected  
2 by ballot at the annual meeting to be held in the month fol-  
3 lowing the end of the fiscal year as is now or shall hereafter  
4 be prescribed by the Public Utilities Commission of the  
5 State of Maine. The clerk and treasurer shall hold office  
6 each for one year, or until successors are chosen and quali-  
7 fied. The assessors shall appoint a collector. At the first  
8 annual meeting of the corporation after the adoption of  
9 this charter, one assessor shall be elected by ballot for one  
10 year, one for two years, and one for three years, and there-  
11 after one assessor shall be elected at each annual meeting  
12 for the term of three years.'
