STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section one hundred thirty-nine of chapter sixteen of the Revised Statutes relating to the appropriation for the encouragement of industrial education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred thirty-nine of chapter sixteen of the
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word
3 "fifty" in the third line thereof and substituting therefor the
4 word 'sixty-four' so that said section when amended shall
5 read as follows:

'Sect. 139. For the purposes of the seven preceding sec-

2 tions there shall be deducted annually by the treasurer of
3 state from the school and mill fund the sum of sixty-four
4 thousand dollars and any unexpended balance of this amount
5 shall be added to the permanent school fund. All reports
6 required under said sections shall be filed annually with the
7 state superintendent of public schools on or before the first
8 day of July, and state aid shall be payable during the month
9 of December next succeeding.'

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The increase in the appropriation is required to meet the provisions of the law requiring reimbursement to towns maintaining courses in industrial education.'
