STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section fourteen of Chapter sixteen, Revised Statutes, 1916, to provide for the approval of plans for the reconstruction or remodeling of school buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section fourteen of Chapter sixteen, Revised Statutes of
2 1916, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "build3 ing" in the sixth line thereof the words 'and plans for the
4 reconstruction or remodeling of any school building, the ex5 pense for which shall exceed five hundred dollars' and by
6 inserting after the word "erect" in the last line thereof the

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7 words 'reconstruct or remodel,' so that said section, when 8 amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 14. Where the plans and specifications prepared by 2 the state superintendent are not used, all superintending 3 school committees of towns in which new buildings are to be 4 erected, shall make suitable provision for the heating, light-5 ing and ventilating and hygienic conditions of such buildings, 6 and all plans and specifications for any such proposed school 7 building and plans for the reconstruction or remodeling of 8 any school building, the expense for which shall exceed five 9 hundred dollars, shall be submitted to and approved by the 10 state superintendent of public schools and the state board of 11 health before the same be accepted by the superintending 12 school committee or school building committee of the town in 13 which it is proposed to erect, reconstruct or remodel such 14 building.'
