# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend section one hundred forty-six of chapter sixteen of the Revised Statutes relating to the appropriation for the support of normal and training schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section one hundred forty-six of chapter sixteen of the
Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the
word "ninety" in the third line thereof and substituting
therefor the words 'one hundred ten' so that said section
when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 146. For the support of the five normal schools

2 and the Madawaska Training School, the sum of one hun3 dred ten thousand dollars is annually appropriated, to be
4 expended under the direction of said trustees, which sum
5 the treasurer of state shall deduct for said purpose from
6 any school money raised for the support of common schools.
7 The governor and council may from time to time, as they
8 think proper, draw warrants therefor on said treasurer in
9 favor of said trustees.'

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The increase in the appropriation is required on account of the usual increase in the cost of maintenance of these schools through additional enrollment of students and a general rise in the cost of materials.
