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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to correct typographical errors in section one hundred and sixteen of chapter seven of the Revised Statutes, relating to Illegal Voting.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section one hundred and sixteen of chapter seven of the  
2 Revised Statutes is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“Sect. 116. At any meeting for the election of any officer,  
2 where a list of voters is necessary, whoever wilfully votes  
3 before the presiding officer has had opportunity to find his  
4 name on said list, or knowing that it is not on it, or wilfully

5 gives any false answer or statement to the municipal officers  
6 of towns, cities or plantations when they shall be previously  
7 preparing such list, or presiding at such meeting, in order  
8 that his name or the name of any other person may be en-  
9 tered on such list, or his vote or that of another be received;  
10 or casts more than one vote at one balloting; or is disor-  
11 derly at such meeting, forfeits for each offense, not exceed-  
12 ceeding one hundred, nor less than ten dollars.”
