STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE in favor of the Reformatory for Women for permanent improvement of the grounds and other purposes for the year nineteen hundred seventeen.

RESOLVED, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated.
2 For the Reformatory for Women. For grading, building
3 roads and walks, and otherwise permanently improving the
4 grounds of said institution, for the year nineteen hundred
5 seventeen, the sum of one thousand five hundred (\$1,500.00)
6 dollars.

For furnishing and equipping the unfinished cottage now
2 under construction, for the year nineteen hundred seventeen,
3 the sum of two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars.

For the completion of the construction of said cottage for
2 the year nineteen hundred seventeen, the sum of two thou-
3 sand (\$2,000.00) dollars.

Provided, that any balance of the sums above appropriated
2 for the year nineteen hundred seventeen which may remain
3 unexpended at the end of the year shall be available for ex-
4 penditure during the year nineteen hundred eighteen, and
5 provided further, that the Governor and Council may, by
6 order, upon recommendation of the trustees of the said in-
7 stitution, authorize the use of unexpended balances of any of
8 the above appropriations to meet deficiencies in other appro-
9 priations for such institution.
