STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to annual or biennial reports of state chari-
table and correctional institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of simplifying and making
2 uniform the accounting of the several state charitable and
3 correctional institutions, namely: Maine State Prison, the
4 Reformatory for Women, State School for Boys, State
5 School for Girls, Augusta State Hospital, Bangor State
6 Hospital, School for the Feeble Minded, the State Sana-
7 toriums for the Treatment of Tuberculosis and the Bath

8 Military and Naval Orphan Asylum, the books of account
9 and record of said institutions shall hereafter be closed on
10 the thirtieth day of June of each year, and the annual or
11 biennial reports which are now required by law to be made
12 by the inspectors, commissioners, trustees and officers hav-
13 ing charge of the said institutions shall hereafter be made
14 annually to the governor and council on or before the thir-
15 tieth day of September, for the year ending on the thirtieth
16 day of June preceding. Said reports shall be printed bi-
17 ennially for the use of the legislature in such numbers and
18 in such form as the governor and council may determine.

Sect. 2. So much of section 31 of chapter 3, revised stat-
2 utes, sections 8, 12 and 60 of chapter 142, revised statutes,
3 section 13 of chapter 144, revised statutes, sections 7 and
4 47 of chapter 145, revised statutes and section 6 of chapter
5 146, revised statutes, or of any other laws in relation to
6 annual or biennial reports of the aforesaid institutions, as
7 are inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby
8 repealed.
