### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Seizure and Forfeiture of Vehicles carrying intoxicating Liquor intended for Illegal Sale.

Be it enacted by the Pcople of the State of Maine, as follows: All automobiles, trucks, wagons, boats, and vehicles of 2 every kind, not common carriers, containing intoxicating 3 liquors intended for illegal sale within the state, found with-4 in the state in the possession or in the control of any person 5 using them for the transportation of intoxicating liquors in-6 tended for illegal sale within the state, shall be seized by any 7 officer seizing the liquors transported therein, shall be libeled

8 as is provided for the libeling of intoxicating liquors and the 9 vessels in which they are contained under chapter one hun-10 dred and twenty-seven of the Revised Statutes, and shall be 11 declared forfeited by the court and sold in the same manner 12 as is provided for the sale of vessels containing intoxicating 13 liquors, provided the use of such vehicle for the transporting 14 of such liquors is with the consent of the owner and with his 15 knowledge that the liquors transported in it are intended for 16 illegal sale within the state.
