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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

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AN ACT to fix the time of payment of salaries of county officials.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The salaries of judges of probate, registers of  
2 probate, clerks of judicial courts, sheriffs, county commis-  
3 sioners, registers of deeds and county treasurers of the sev-  
4 eral counties, shall be paid in equal monthly payments on the  
5 last day of each month.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the  
2 provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
