IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the World Standard
Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the World Standard
2 Insurance Company, which were granted by chapter two
3 hundred nine of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
4 hundred eleven, are hereby extended for two years from
5 date on which this act takes effect; and the persons named
6 in said act, their associates and successors shall have the
7 rights, powers and privileges that were granted to them by
8 said act, to be exercised by them for the same purposes as
9 specified in said act.
